I understand that it is an offence to provide false information to the registration officer, that if it is suspected that this declaration is false the matter will be passed to the PSNI and that upon conviction for contravention of section 13D of the Representation of the People Act 1983 a person is liable to imprisonment for up to six months, a fine up to £1,000, or to both.

1. This declaration must be accompanied by the Electoral Identity Card application form, otherwise it will be returned to you.
2. You must give surname and all your forenames so that your identity can be verified. Please use CAPITALS
3. We need this to check your identity.
4. You must give a contact telephone number. Spot checks will be made on the authenticity of declarations.
5. You must actually see the applicant so that you can check the photograph is a true likeness. You must not simply accept what others tell you.
6. You must keep a record of all declarations you complete.
7. You must sign the declaration personally. Electronic signatures, signature stamps or other facsimile signatures are not acceptable.
