1. Last day for publication of notice of election Not later than Wednesday 4 May 1994
2. Delivery of nomination papers Not later than 4pm Thursday 12 May 1994

Returning Officer in attendance at 3rd Floor, 65/67 Chichester Street, Belfast BT1 4JD for receipt of nomination papers -

10am to 4pm - Thursday 5 May, Friday 6 May, Monday 9 May, Tuesday 10 May, Wednesday 11 May, Thursday 12 May 1994

3. Delivery of notices of withdrawals of candidature Within the time for the delivery of nomination papers
4. The making of objections to nomination papers During the hours allowed for delivery of nomination papers but not later than 5pm on Thursday 12 May 1994 - no objection may be made in the afternoon of Thursday 12 May 1994 except to a nomination paper delivered within 24 hours of the last time for its delivery and in the case of a nomination paper so delivered no objection may be so made to the sufficiency or nature of the particulars of the candidate unless made at or immediately after the time of the delivery of the nomination paper: and the foregoing provisions do not apply to objections made in pursuance of rule 15 (2).
5. Publication of statement of persons nominated Thursday 12 May at 5pm or as soon afterwards as any objections are disposed of
6. Last day for receipt of postal and proxy vote applications Not later than **NOON** on Friday 20 May 1994
7. Last day for receipt of late postal vote applications on grounds of unforeseen illness Not later than **NOON** on Wednesday 1 June 1994
8. Last day for appointment of Polling/ Verification and Counting Agents Not later than Tuesday 7 June 1994
9. POLL Thursday 9 June 1994 between the hours of 7am and 10pm
10. VERIFICATION Friday 10 June 1994
11. COUNTING COMMENCES Monday 13 June 1994

HOLIDAYS EXCLUDED MONDAY 2ND AND MONDAY 30TH MAY 1994

12. Last day for delivery of returns and declarations as to election expenses 35 days after the day on which the result of the election is declared
13. Last day for publication of time and place for inspection of returns and declarations Ten days after the last day for delivery of returns and declarations as to election expenses
