(a) Number of people who, quite properly, are register more than once as voters in Northern Ireland.

(b) Number of these in the South Belfast and Fermanagh and South Tyrone constituencies respectively.

Belfast South 4  
Fermanagh and South Tyrone 1

(c) Number of people properly registered in both Belfast South and Fermanagh and South Tyrone.

It would be possible, if it was alleged that any such person had contravened the law by voting twice, to check the marked register for their allotted polling stations and the marked postal votes lists for their constituencies. Such a check would clearly show whether an offence had been committed.

The information is currently being gathered in respect of the other matters that you have raised and I hope to be in a position to let you have a substantive reply by the end of the month.
