

Application to vote by post or proxy for an indefinite period on the grounds of attendance at an educational institution

If you are unable to go to your polling station to vote at an election because of the attendance of you or your spouse at a course at an educational establishment and that is likely to last for at least two years, you can use this form to apply to vote by post or to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf. Please read these notes carefully before completing the form. If you have any questions please phone your local Area Electoral Office (contact details below).

Completing the application form

1 Complete your personal details. The information you provide and your signature will be compared with the information previously given on your registration form to check that they correspond. **If you are unable to sign this form you should consider appointing a proxy as your signature will be needed at a later stage in the processing of a postal vote.**

2 Provide the reason for the application and tick the relevant box.

Please ensure you provide sufficient detail to support your application or your application may be refused.

3 Choose to vote by post or proxy.

Voting by post. Tick the box if you want your ballot paper sent to you at your registered address given at Section 1. If you want your ballot paper to be sent to a different address than your registered address, you must provide a reason for this.

Note: If you apply to vote by post and your application is approved you will **not** be able to vote at a polling station unless you cancel your postal vote.

4 **Voting by proxy.** If you want someone else to vote on your behalf you must appoint him/her and provide his/her details. Your proxy must be aged 18 or over and a British, Irish, European or Commonwealth citizen.

A person can only vote as proxy for close relatives and up to two other people at an election. Your proxy can go to your polling station to vote, or they can apply to vote by post. If your proxy requires a postal vote please contact us for guidance.

5 Sign the form to verify that the information provided is correct. If you are unable to sign please see note 1.

6 The form must be attested by a qualified person to verify that the reason you have given for requiring a postal or proxy vote is correct.

The only persons who by law are qualified to attest section 6 are listed below:

- a Director or tutor of the course attended
- a principal or head of the institution attended
- an employee delegated by the head or principal of that institution
