

Public Notice of Petition to Remove the MP for North Antrim, Ian Paisley

Constituency	North Antrim

There will be a petition to decide whether Ian Paisley, the MP for North Antrim should lose his seat as an MP and a by-election held to decide who would be the MP for that constituency.

The petition has been started because Ian Paisley MP has been suspended from sitting in the House of Commons for thirty days for breaching the code of conduct for MPs.

These will be open for signing Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm, as well as on 6 and 13 September 2018 to 9pm.

A person is eligible to sign the petition if they are a registered parliamentary elector for the constituency, aged 18 or over (or the date of their 18th birthday is before the end of the signing period) and the person would be entitled to vote as an elector at a parliamentary election in the constituency.
