- a driving licence (photographic part)
- an electoral identity card
- a Translink Half Fare SmartPass, Senior SmartPass, Blind Person's SmartPass, War Disabled SmartPass or 60+ SmartPass
- any card with the PASS logo
- an identity card issued to you by an EU country
- a marriage or civil partnership certificate
- a passport
- a certificate of adoption
- a biometric immigration document issued by the Home Office
- a BSO medical card

Nationality - provide ANY ONE of the following documents:

- a birth certificate
- a certificate of naturalisation
- a document showing that you have become a Commonwealth citizen by virtue of registration
- a statutory declaration that you are a qualifying Commonwealth, Irish or EU citizen
- a UK, Irish, EU or Commonwealth passport
- a biometric immigration document issued by the Home Office
- a National Identity Card
- Commonwealth citizens must also provide proof that they have Leave to Remain in the UK

Address - provide ANY ONE of the following documents issued within the last 3 months:

- a bank, building society or credit union statement*
- a debit or credit card statement*
- a mortgage statement*
- a rates bill
- an electricity, gas, water or telephone bill (including mobile phone)
- a HM Revenue and Customs P2 Notice of Coding Form or Tax Credit award letter
- a benefit statement issued by the Social Security Agency
- a driving licence (photographic part)
- a tenancy agreement issued by a housing association

* you can cut off or delete the account number and the details of the transactions

National Insurance Number - provide ANY ONE of the following documents:

- a national insurance card

- a HM Revenue and Customs P2 Notice of Coding Form or Tax Credit award letter
