You can use this form to apply to vote by post or to appoint a proxy to vote on your behalf. Please read these notes carefully before completing the form. If you have any questions please contact us (see below).

Completing the application form

- 1** Complete your personal details. The information you provide and your signature may be compared with the information previously given on your registration form to check that they correspond. For further information see the privacy notice on our website or contact us to obtain a paper copy. If you are unable to sign this form because of a disability or because you are unable to read you should ask someone to witness the form for you. You must also give your **Digital Registration number (DRN)**. Your application will not be accepted without it. This number will be sent to you by the Electoral Office on a Certificate of Registration when your registration has been approved.

2 Voting by post

Tick the box if you want your ballot paper sent to you at your qualifying address given at Section 1. Please note that ballot papers cannot be sent to an address outside the United Kingdom. If you cannot give an address within the UK you should consider applying for a proxy vote.

Your ballot paper may be sent to you as late as one week before election day which may not allow enough time for you to return your ballot paper before voting closes, so it may not be the best way for you to vote. Please note that if you have applied to vote by post, you cannot vote in person on election day.

3 Voting by proxy

If you want someone else to vote on your behalf, you must appoint him/her and provide his/her details. Your proxy must be registered and eligible to vote.

A proxy can vote for a maximum of 4 people. No more than 2 of these people can be domestic electors. Domestic electors are voters who are neither overseas voters nor service voters.

Your proxy will be sent a proxy poll card telling them where and when to vote.

If you can go to the polling station on polling day you can vote provided you do so before your proxy and provided your proxy has not applied to vote for you by post. If your proxy is unable to attend your polling station and wants to vote by post, please contact us at AV.info@eoni.org.uk
