# Application for Permanent Postal Vote - Education



If you, or your spouse/civil partner attend a course at an educational institution and are unable to go to your Polling Station to vote at elections, you can use this form to apply for a **permanent postal vote**. This is where your ballot paper is posted to you before election day, for you to complete & return by post. Postal votes are sent out up to 2 weeks before election day.

You must be registered to vote to apply for a postal vote. If you are unsure if you are registered to vote, go online and check at [www.eoni.org.uk/can-i-vote](http://www.eoni.org.uk/can-i-vote)

- 1** Complete your personal details. You can get your National Insurance Number online at [www.gov.uk/lost-national-insurance-number](http://www.gov.uk/lost-national-insurance-number). Providing contact information is optional – either a telephone number or an email address.

Your information will be checked with the electoral register and, if inaccurate your application will be rejected.

- 2** If you registered to vote online, then you **MUST** provide your **Digital Registration Number (DRN)**. Most people are registered to vote online - you should check your DRN at [www.eoni.org.uk/DRN](http://www.eoni.org.uk/DRN)

If you do not know your DRN, you can request it online at [www.eoni.org.uk/DRN](http://www.eoni.org.uk/DRN) or find it on your letter of electoral registration confirmation.

If your application is rejected on these grounds, we will treat it as a request for your DRN and send it to you.

- 3** Tick the box if you want your postal vote sent to your address at Section 1.

Otherwise write in the alternative address you want your postal vote sent to. You must provide a reason for this.

- 4** Sign & date the form to verify the information you provided is correct. If you cannot sign the form due to a disability or an inability to read/write, someone else must witness & sign your application.

- 5** You need to state if you are making this application based on your attendance on an education course or if it is your spouse or civil partners attendance.

You must provide a reason why you need to vote by postal vote, for example

*'I live away from home during the course term times and it is too far away to go to my polling station'*

You must also provide the course name the person is attending & when the course ends.

- 6** **You must have the form attested or supported by another person** to verify your reason for a postal vote. If your application is not attested it will be refused.

Only a

- director/tutor of the course;
- principal/head of institution; or
- an employee of educational institution with delegated authority

can complete and attest this form for you.

That person must know you (or your spouse or civil partner) are currently attending the course specified.

That person must also satisfy the other criteria stated.
