Application for Permanent Proxy Vote - Education



If you, or your spouse/civil partner attends a course at an educational institution and you are unable to go to your Polling Station to vote at elections, you can use this form to apply for a **permanent proxy vote**. This is where you appoint someone to vote on your behalf at your Polling Station on election day.

You must be registered to vote to apply for a proxy vote. If you are unsure if you are registered to vote, go online and check at <u>www.eoni.org.uk/can-l-vote</u>

 Complete your personal details. You can get your National Insurance Number online at www.gov.uk/lost-national-insurance-number. Providing contact information is optional – either a telephone number or an email address. Your information will be checked with the electoral register and, if inaccurate your application will be rejected.
